

A warm greeting is extended to all who have come to worship with our community of faith. We are grateful for our faithful parishioners who are here every week. We also welcome all our visitors and invite you to consider joining our parish. If you are not Catholic, we encourage you to contact our Parish Office for information about becoming a member of the Church.

PARISH REGISTRATION is held in the vestibule of the Church after all Masses on the 1st and 3rd weekends of the month. You may also register at the Parish Office on weekdays during business hours.

BAPTISM is usually celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month at 12:00PM. Please call Mrs. Gauntner at 610-666-0167 for upcoming baptism dates. Parents must attend our Pre-Jordan Class prior to their child's baptism. Our next Pre-Jordan class will be held at 7:00PM on Wednesday March 21, 2018 in our Parish Center.

MATRIMONY: Couples must make arrangements for matrimony in person with the Pastor at least six months prior to date of their anticipated wedding ceremony. One of the parties must have family registered in the parish at the time the couple comes to make arrangements. Please call the Parish Office for an appointment with Father Wild.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Parishioners who are seriously ill, weakened by advanced age, or entering the hospital for surgery are encouraged to request the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Homebound sick and elderly may receive Holy Communion in their homes on a regular basis. Please contact the Parish Office to arrange for a home visit or to request an anointing.

Thank you to all who came out for our 4th Annual Lenten Soup & Speaker event on Mon. Feb. 19. Fr. Kevin DiPrinzio, OSA gave a very informative and enlightening presentation on our patron saint, St. Teresa of Avila. I really appreciate the generosity of all those who shared their time, talents and treasure in making this a lovely evening of food, faith and fellowship!

During this season of Lent, St. Teresa of Avila Parish is participating in an active prayer chain within the church community. Colorful flags are available for parishioners to write prayer requests, the name of someone you would like to pray for or a special intention.

The flags will then be hung on a line near the statue of Our Blessed Mother on the parish grounds. You have the opportunity to add to the prayer chain throughout the Lenten season. Baskets with blank flags will be in the vestibules of the church along with markers and clips. You may hang your completed flag on the line outside or leave it on the table at the back of church and it will be hung for you.

This project is in honor of Our Lady, Undoer of Knots; much like the grotto outside the Cathedral Basilica SS. Pater & Paul during Pope Francis' visit to Philadelphia. We encourage you to write of the knots in your own spiritual life. If we do this in true surrender to Our Blessed Mother, She will take our flags and undo even the most impossible of knots!

Please make an effort and mark on your calendars the dates of **March 4 -7** and plan to be present to share in our Parish Mission.




