


BAPTISM is usually celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month at 12:00PM. Please call Mrs. Gauntner at 610-666-0167 for upcoming baptism dates. Parents must attend our Pre-Jordan Class prior to their child's baptism. Our next Pre-Jordan class will be held at 7:00PM on Wednesday July 18, 2018 in our Parish Center.

MATRIMONY: Couples must make arrangements for matrimony in person with the Pastor at least six months prior to date of their anticipated wedding ceremony. One of the parties must have family registered in the parish at the time the couple comes to make arrangements. Please call the Parish Office for an appointment with Father Wild.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Parishioners who are seriously ill, weakened by advanced age, or entering the hospital for surgery are encouraged to request the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Homebound sick and elderly may receive Holy Communion in their homes on a regular basis. Please contact the Parish Office to arrange for a home visit or to request an anointing.




My Dear Parishioners,

Pontifical Mission Societies

Fr. Amal, SdC, a priest of the Servants of Charity, will be preaching, on behalf of the Mission Cooperation Appeal, at the Masses on the weekend of July 7th and 8th. The Servants of Charity, founded by the recently canonized (in 2011) St. Luigi Guanella, are an international congregation whose ministries, primarily, are with persons with intellectual disabilities; the elderly who are poor; and children in difficulty. The Servants of Charity serve at residential programs for persons with intellectual disabilities (The Communities of Don Guanella and Divine Providence and St. Edmond's Home) in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Fr. Amal will be speaking on behalf of the missions of the Servants of Charity in India, Philippines and Vietnam in which the Servants of Charity serve orphans, persons with physical handicaps, persons with intellectual disabilities, persons with mental illness, undernourished pre-school children and the elderly who are poor. A second collection will be taken up at the Masses during the weekend of July 7th and 8th and your generous support of their missionary efforts would be much appreciated.



<u>Linda Richmond Scholarship</u>: Named for Ms. Linda Richmond, a devoted MTC substitute teacher, this scholarship is designated for a child who exhibits the same qualities Linda had; love of school, love of others, and love of community. This will be measured through the student's commitment to MTC. Financial need will also be considered in awarding this scholarship.

<u>Class of 2018 Alumni Scholarship</u>: Started by the MTC Class of 2018 as a gift to the school, this scholarship is designated for a student who exhibits pride in MTC, is an active member of the school community, and gives of their time in service. Financial need will also be considered in awarding this scholarship.

Boy Scout Scholarship: The Boy Scouts of America is one of the nation's largest and most prominent values-based youth development organizations, providing programs for young people that build character, trains them in the responsibilities of participating citizenship, and develops personal fitness.
